Eagles Donate Nearly \$1 Million in Charitable Grants During International Convention

From parades and caricature artists to palm readers and stilt walkers, the full authentic New Orleans experience was on display as the Fraternal Order of Eagles International Convention hit the Big Easy.

From August 3-8, Eagles from across North America descended upon the Hilton Riverside Hotel for the greatest Eagles week of the year. During the day, the Grand Aerie offered a variety of classes, teaching members about Grants, QuickBooks, Ritual, Officer Duties, MMS, Marketing, Auxiliary Responsibilities and more.

In the evenings, the Eagles enjoyed sharing memories, listening to great music, and laughing with an incredible lineup of entertainers, including country legend Tracy Lawrence, comedian Killer Beaz and country artist Rodney Watts.

While members enjoyed seeing the bold Mardi Gras outfits and exploring the Big Easy, the best part of our annual gathering was raising money for charities. Eagles are proudly known as "People Helping People," and the week served as a showcase of exactly what we do and how we uphold that motto.

Several different groups were hard at work raising money. The Memorial Foundation collected \$5,541 and Eagle Village collected \$6,251 through a variety of basket raffles. Our Auxiliary raised \$5,880 from our Eagle Village gown sale, while IBA and Nightcappers collected \$3,081 and \$1,000 respectively. To top it off, our daily 50/50 drawings collected a whopping \$22,034 forthe F.O.E. Charity Foundation.

Through raffles, parade of checks and other donations, the F.O.E. raised \$165, 739 for the Charity Foundation, \$21,071 for the Memorial Foundation and \$22, 381 for Eagle Village for a grand total of \$209,191. It was truly amazing to see all of our Eagles working together and embracing who we are as "People Helping People."

On Tuesday night at the Aerie & Auxiliary Members Banquet, Jr. Past Grand Worthy President Chuck Weber presented a check for \$296,543 to Children's Hospital Colorado's Autism program—his special project for the year. That same night, Jr. Past Grand Madam President Becky Wilson presented \$168,704 for Meals on Wheels. Their donations were part of a total of \$985,419 in grants presented during the International Convention.

Members also had the chance to buy brand new items at the F.O .E. Store, including the 2024 Children's Art Contest

We ended the week on Thursday evening with the Installation of your new Grand Presidents, Peter Ackers and Mary Gutierrez, and the rest of our 2024-25 Grand Aerie and Grand Auxiliary Officers.
